Rotation

The two-year program allows graduates to rotate through various opportunities at the home branch (Dublin) and, should they so wish, also at our factory sites and other sales branches in Europe.

Where international or cross-functional rotation is either not possible or not desired by the graduate, another rotation within the "home" branch may be considered instead.

Rotation will be with Marketing, Finance and HR with last rotation overseas.

The role commences in September 2024 and rotations at 6 month intervals.
